Q: ARE THERE TUITION/FEE DISCOUNTS FOR BOARD MEMBERS?

A: NO, THERE ARE NO DISCOUNTS GIVEN TO BOARD MEMBERS.

Q: IS THE BOARD RESPONSIBLE FOR HIRING SCHOOL EMPLOYEES?

A: THE BOARD IS ONLY RESPONSIBLE FOR HIRING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. THE BOARD CANNOT HIRE OR FIRE ANY OTHER SCHOOL EMPLOYEE.

COLLEGE-PREP CURRICULUM

All subjects are taught from a Christian perspective. Abeka is used through 5th grade as our primary resource to develop traditional and foundational academic skills. Other resources are incorporated as well to enhance the development of critical thinking, creativity, and communication skills. The baseline of our 6th-12th grade curriculum are college-prep courses, with additional Honors and Dual Enrollment classes available in high school.

FAITH-BASED COMMUNITY

Although we are not affiliated with any particular church or doctrine, CP students participate in school facilitated prayer, scripture memorization, and monthly devotionals. Elementary students begin each day honoring Christ in prayer and scripture reading, honoring their country by reciting the Pledge of Allegiance, and honoring others by reciting the Redhawk Way and character traits. 6th-12th grade students and faculty gather together for Monday Morning Manna to start each week with a prayer, scripture reading, and worship song.

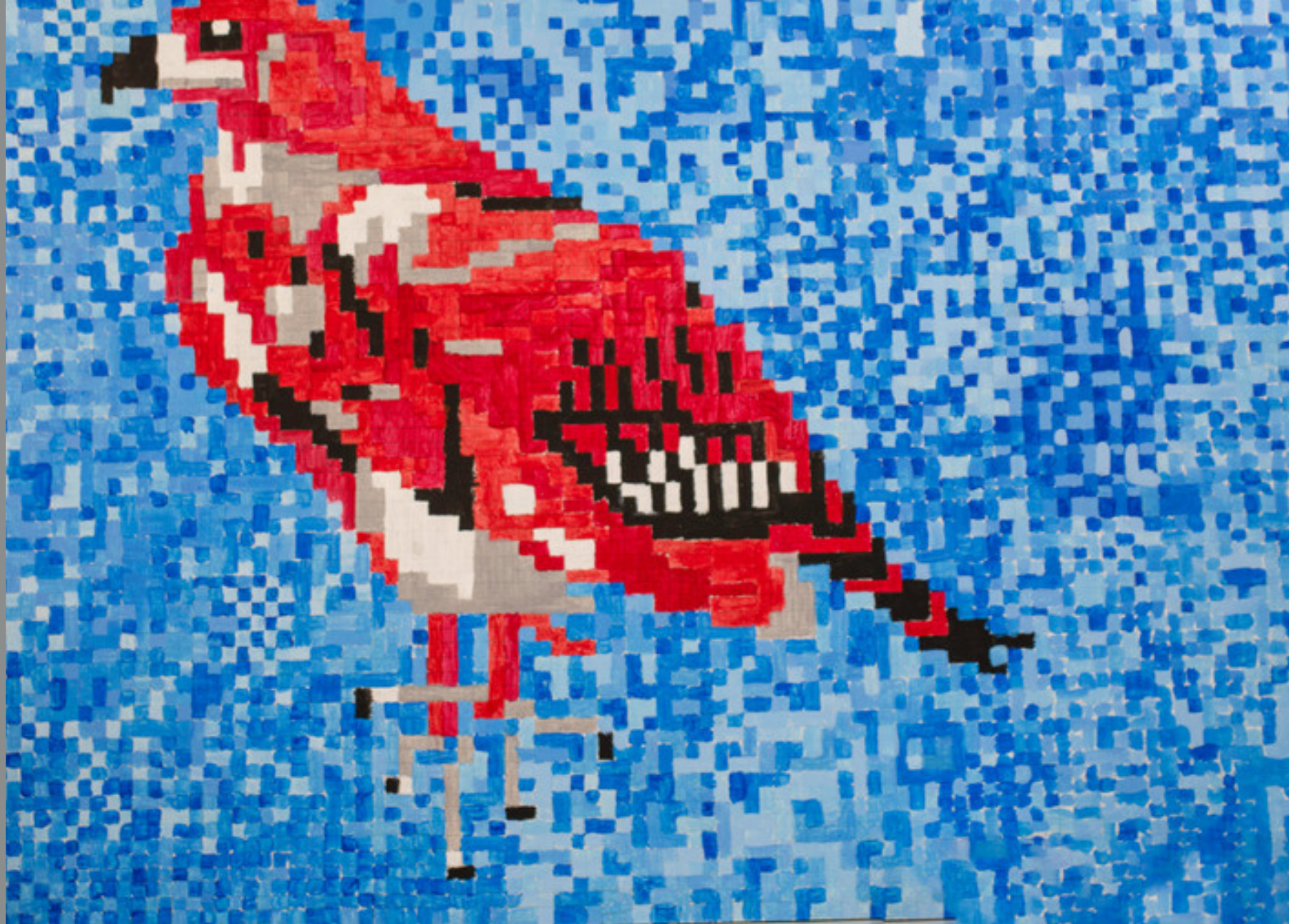

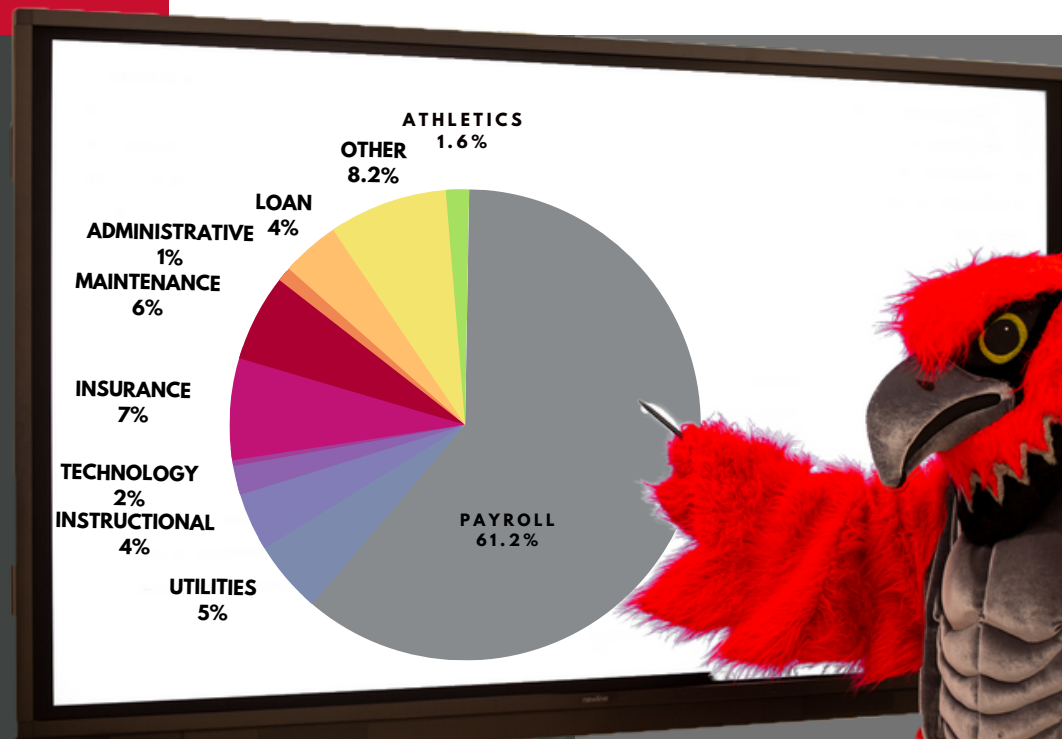

All funds raised by PTF events are directly donated to our students, their classroom environment and support of our faculty and staff.



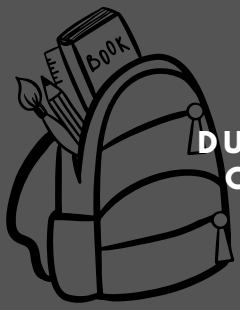

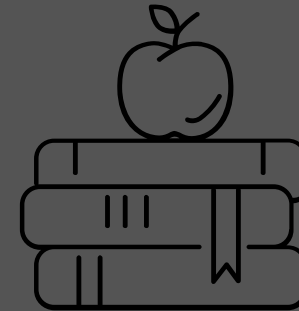

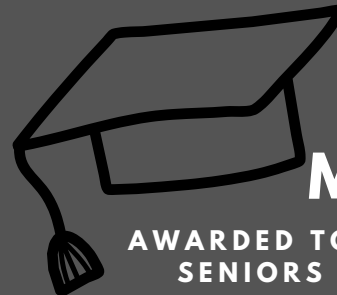
